

THE 10th ANNIVERSARY BARCADERE CLASSIC

SCHEDULE OF PRIZES AND SPONSORS

The primary target species for The Barcadere Classic is the Wahoo and the prizes are focused accordingly. Wahoo are commonly found around our islands this time of year in the 50lb to 90lb range, but can weigh in excess of 150lbs. The local record currently held by Mr. Elvitt Connolly is for a 146lbs 2oz. Wahoo, caught June 3rd 2007, on 130lb test monofilament aboard Miss Michelle with Capt. Mikey Ebanks. This is only 37lbs 14oz less than the current IGFA world record of 184lbs, caught in Mexico in 2005, which demonstrates just how productive fishing for this Pelagic species can be in these waters.
